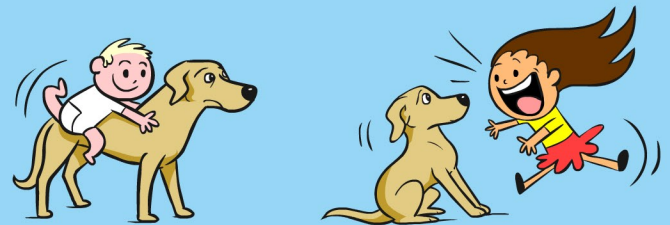
The problem is no one has taught parents what they should be watching for.

## 1. Tense canine body language



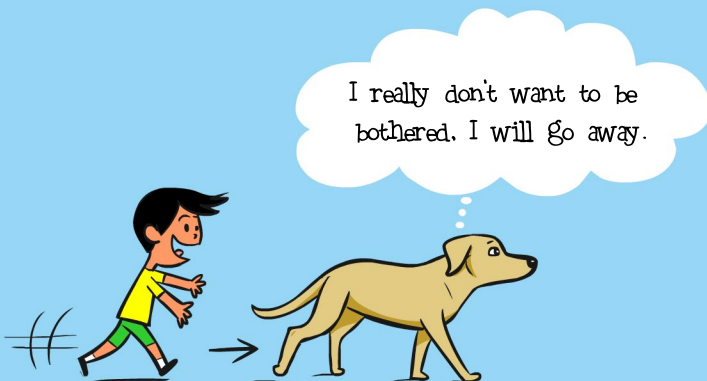
## 2. Inappropriate human behavior
